NATIONAL ELECTRIFICATION ADMINISTRATION BOARD OF ADMINISTRATORS (NEA BOA) MEETING HELD IN MORESCO-1 MAIN OFFICE



Last February 18-20, 2020 the NEA Board of Administrators and Executive Officials gathered for a series of meetings in MORESCO-1 Laguindingan, Misamis Oriental to discuss a wide range of business concerns affecting the power industry.

NEA board member Agustin Maddatu, Board Governance, Nomination and Remuneration Chair, presided over the first meeting on February 18. Alternate Chairman Emmanuel Juaneza, Administrator Edgardo Masongsong, board members Rene Gonzales and Alpio Cirilo Badelles were all in attendance together with Deputy Administrators Sonia San Diego (Corporate Resources and Financial Services), Rossan Rosero-Lee (Legal Services), Vicar Loureen Lofranco (Electric Cooperative Management Services) and Artis Nikki Tortola (Technical Services).

During the welcome program, Administrator Masongsong thanked MORESCO-1 General Manager Jovel Ubay-ubay and Board President Allan Sofocado along with the MORESCO-1 workforce for welcoming the NEA and hosting the committee meetings and regular board meetings. He cited that this is the first time that the NEA BOA is held outside of NEA.

A quick consultative meeting between the NEA executives and the members of the Northern Mindanao Electric Cooperatives Association, Inc. (NORMECA) headed by MORESCO-1 Director Nonito Labis also took place, Tuesday evening.

During the fellowship night, MORESCO-1 workforce wholeheartedly welcomed the NEA BOA and NORMECA delegates with an Aliwan Festival themed dance number showcasing the Panagbenga (Luzon), Sinulog (Visayas), and Kaamulan (Mindanao) festivals.



MORESCO-1'S 2020 SEQUENTIAL ANNUAL GENERAL MEMBERSHIP ASSEMBLY (AGMA) APPROVED BY NATIONAL ELECTRIFICATION ADMINISTRATION (NEA)

In the MORESCO-1 Board of Directors Special Meeting held last January 27, 2020, the BOD has seen and decided that the conduct of a sequential Annual General Membership Assembly (AGMA) is the most responsive arrangement to cater enough number of member-consumer-owners (MCOs) without compromising the quality of discussions as compared to one venue only for AGMA, as practiced in the previous years.

The sequential AGMA is also foreseen to maximize the collaborations of the stakeholders within the district and strengthen the relationships of the LGUs both from the Municipal and Barangay levels.

The National Electrification Administration approved MORESCO-1 BOD Resolution for a sequential AGMA on February 3, 2020.

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M1 WORKFORCE UNDERGO MANDATORY 8-HOUR SAFETY AND HEALTH AWARENESS SEMINAR



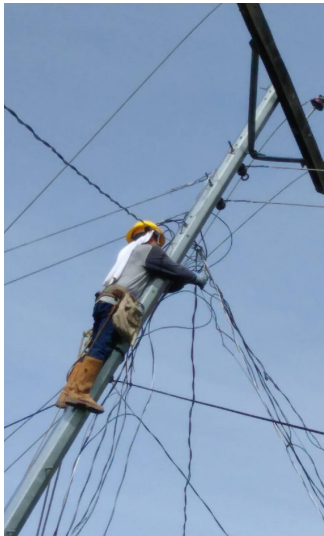
